Key Facts

Henri Rousseau (May 21st 1844- Sept 2nd 1910)

- Born in France
- He started painting seriously when he was 49.

Edwin Butler Bayliss (1874-1950)

- An English artist who was based in the Black Country.
- He is famous for his realistic paintings of industrial areas.
- He was born in Wolverhampton , on Merridale Raod. He spent his childhood in Finchfield and Tettenhall.

Key Vocabulary

Expressionism- tried to convey emotion and meaning rather than reality. Each artist had their own unique way of "expressing" their emotions in their art. In order to express emotion, the subjects are often distorted or exaggerated. At the same time colours are often vivid and shocking.

Surrealism-explored the subconscious areas of the mind. The artwork often made little sense as it was usually trying to depict a dream or random thoughts.
