**Pablo Picasso** (25<sup>th</sup> October 1881 – 8<sup>th</sup> April 1973)

- Born in Spain

### Roman Art Mosaic

- Mosaics were made up of hundreds, sometimes thousands, of tiny coloured stones and gems called tesserae. Each mosaic piece was stuck to the floor with mortar, a type of cement. Mosaics would show pictures of Roman history and everyday Roman life.
