Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Pendeford Mill

As part of their Geography curriculum, arrangements have been made for the Year 5 children to visit Pendeford Mill **on Wednesday 3rd July 2024**. The children will travel to and from the nature reserve by coach and return by the end of the school day.

A visit of this kind would be most valuable in enriching the children's experience and providing a basis for much written, display and other work. We will be aiming to achieve the following objectives from the visit:

- To investigate temperate forests
- To investigate habitats of British wildlife

On the day, children need to wear their own clothes. A waterproof coat or anorak and / or sun hat will be needed, as they will be outside all day. Children are required to have suntan lotion applied at home, and can reapply independently at lunchtime, if necessary. All children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink / refillable bottle in a backpack. Please ensure the drink / refillable bottle is in a plastic or cardboard container – no fizzy drinks, thank you. No spending money is required for this visit.

In order for this visit to take place, we do ask parents for a contribution towards the cost of this trip and that cost is £8.00. If you would like your child to take part in this visit, please visit your School Gateway app to give parental consent and pay the £8.00 – select payments and 'Y5 Pendeford Mill'.

We feel it is important for your child to take part in educational visits, and yet, if you do not want your child to participate then please let the school office know as soon as possible; this will avoid any unnecessary reminders. The deadline for parental consent and payment is end of day, on Monday 1st July 2024. Please note if we do not have sufficient numbers then the trip will be cancelled and monies shall be refunded.
